Reception Visit to Rays Farm

As you may know, Reception have recently been learning all about 'Fantastic Animals'. Next half term, our topic will be 'Where shall we go?' and to link the two very exciting topics together, we are going to the farm! I am delighted to tell you that we have been able to organise a visit to Rays Farm for the children next half term. This will be on Monday 19th June for all of the children in Reception. We will be leaving school at 9.15am and will be returning for 3.30pm. This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to find out about all of the animals and what happens on the farm.

At Rays Farm the children will have the chance to take part in a fairytale forest walk where they will find mythical characters from fairytales and nursery rhymes. The children will also be able to take part in the search for Oscar the giant who has a very special chair in the forest, a perfect place to have a story. As well as this, there is a forest play area where the children will be encouraged to work together as a team to build dens.

The cost of the visit is £12.00 which will need to be paid through our Parentpay system. This is the price of the coach and admission to the farm.

The children will need a packed lunch in a labelled carrier bag and a drink in a disposable plastic bottle or carton, to minimise the amount of baggage on the coach. Children will wear their own clothes, not uniform on this occasion, but clothes and



shoes need to be suitable for outdoor play/walking. Also a waterproof jacket and sunhat will be required as we never know the British weather! We would like sun cream to be applied to all children at home, and this can be sent into school with your child's name on, and they may apply further sun cream themselves if necessary. There is an attached medical/consent form which needs to be returned to school as soon as possible please.

This is a truly magical experience for the children which will bring our learning to life. If you have any questions at all, please do not hesitate to contact Miss Bradshaw.
