## Castlecroft Primary School - Sports Premium Funding – April 2016 - April 2017

From September 2013 the government allocated funding directly to primary schools to support the provision of quality in PE and sport. Each school has received £8,000 plus an extra £5 per pupil each year for the next two years.

At Castlecroft Primary, this will mean **£8,950** April 2016-April 2017.

To allow every KS2 class to be taught PE by our PE coordinator and class teacher Mr Morgan – 1 lesson per week.	£3217
To provide out of school sporting club provision (including 2 lunchtimes) with particular focus on targeted groups of vulnerable children – we will offer netball, football, girls football, cross country, athletics, rugby, and a KS1 sports club in the Autumn Term. Mr Morgan is employed to deliver 3 after school clubs, 2 lunchtime clubs and coordinate competitions.	£2144
To further develop and improve competitive sport within the school curriculum, providing more opportunities for extra-curricular sport & establish relationships with other schools and outside clubs – we plan to enter every available competitive sport offered by the WASPS and PASS teams.	
Release PE Co-ordinator to co-ordinate PE students from Smestow Secondary School to provide opportunities for PE students to gain regular experience of assisting with PE lessons.	£678
Release PE Coordinator to quality assure PE provision and monitor the quality of teaching, learning and data outcomes each term.	
Release time for class teachers to observe PE specialist	
To allow staff to attend professional development opportunities in PE/sport. Mr Morgan – 3 modules of the YST Sports Leadership Course & Black Country Primary PE and Sport Premium Conference.	£1,080
To improve the quality & consistency of provision of PE & help improve staff confidence in their delivery to improve levels and standards – 2 NQT Sports courses supplied by the PASS team.	
To fund coach transport for Year 3 and 5 Sports Festivals organised by the PASS team.	£360
The employment of a gymnastics co-ordinator to run 2 after-school gymnastics clubs.	£863
Swimming Pool hire to allow 1 full term of swimming provision for our Year 5 class.	£408
Ongoing lifeguard training for our 'in house' trained lifeguard	£200
