

Data Protection Act 2018/General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

You may have heard that the law which manages how we use your information has changed.

A new Data Protection Act came into effect on 25 May 2018. This updated legislation introduces the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) into UK law.

The aim of this law is to ensure all personal data is protected and organisations who work with such data are held accountable for its protection.

How We Use Your Information

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) encourages organisations that are responsible for using people's information to make sure it is clear why we need your information and how it is used.

To help explain how your information is used we have published a Privacy Notice on our website, which you can read.

We are also taking the opportunity to review how we manage data and our GDPR compliance. Castlecroft is committed to the highest standards of information security, privacy and transparency.

Data Protection Officer
