## **Year 1 Teamwork and Leadership**

#### **National Curriculum objectives**

To be able to interact and follow instructions to work effectively as a team.

#### **Key Learning**

To be able to interact and follow instructions to work effectively as a team.

## **Equipment and Resources**

- Paper and pens or mini-whiteboards; one for each group of four pupils.
- Space to move around in; ideally a hall though a classroom with tables pushed to the sides would be sufficient.
- Scarves to be used as blindfolds (see main activity, step 2)
- A5 Paper and pencils; One per pupil.

# **Key Vocabulary**

**Communication:** The act of giving, receiving, and sharing information via talking, writing, listening or reading.

**Encouragement:** To motivate and support using positive language.

**Problem solving:** The act of defining a problem; determining the cause of the problem; identifying, prioritising, and selecting alternatives for a solution. **Teamwork:** Working together and supporting other members of your team in a selection.

**Teamwork:** Working together and supporting other members of your team in a game.

**Verbal:** Communicating by speech and spoken word rather than written.
