

This week would have been Art Week in school and we are very sad that the children have missed this-but fear not we are going to move it to later this year when all the children have returned to school.

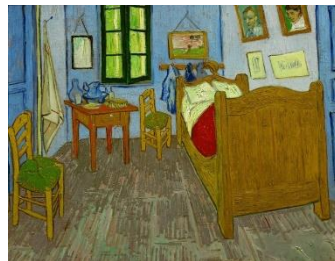
However to get you ready for the Art week theme we invite you to take part in the Castlecroft Primary School Van Gogh project and competition.
